The Martha's Vineyard Public Schools through the Martha's Vineyard Insurance Agency, Inc. will be providing accident insurance for all enrolled students. The master policy will be on file with the Superintendent of Schools. This letter is intended to give you a brief summary of the coverage and the claims procedure.

The coverage outlined below will be in effect for students while at school, traveling to and from school, and at school-sponsored activities.
