## Did you know...

**Meals on Wheels** delivers meals to homebound seniors 60 or older in every town. Frozen meals for the weekend are available.

**The Island Food Pantry** is open year round on Monday (2-4pm), Wednesday (2-4pm) and Saturday (10am-12pm). You can receive three bags of food each visit: one bag of basic groceries, one bag of produce, and a third bag of selected food donations. For a second visit bring a referral note. Visits are limited to once every two weeks.
